

Youth Transitions Implementation Road Map

Spring 2022



- Indefinite extension to Temporary Housing and Temporary Support Agreements.
- Flexibility to AYA life-skills, rehabilitative and mental health options maintained.

Summer 2022



- No-limit earnings exemption so that benefits are not reduced or impacted based on employment.



Complete

Fall 2022



- Rent supplement program (\$600/month).
- Access life-skills programs from across BC and online. No longer limited to ministry program list.
- New transitions workers begin to be available.

2022

Winter 2023

- Youth Transitions gets a new name through youth-led process.

Summer 2023



- Funding for life-skills, training, and cultural programming.



2023

Fall 2023



- Enhanced medical benefits, including expanded dental coverage and access to counselling.
- More Transition Workers become available around the province.

Spring 2024



- Expanded eligibility for post-19 supports and services.
- Duration of support increased to 84 months, up to age 27.
- Housing Agreements to remain in your homes up to age 21.

- Unconditional income supplement at age 19, up to 20th birthday.
- With full implementation of the new comprehensive package of supports, AYA program will be sunsetted.
